Same subject already being taught in core assignment

Same grade level as core assignment

Cannot constitute more than half of the teacher's total assignment

Can be Academic or Elective

Must be grade 5-8

Not authorized to be part of a core setting:
 Departmentalized ELD
 General Technical Education (CTE) services

#### Transitional Kindergarten (TK)

 First year of a 2 year kindergarten program

Require a Multiple Subject credential

Currently issued documents that authorize teaching TK:

 Full Multiple Subject Credential, University Intern, District Intern, GELAP, STSP, PIP



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#### Transitional Kindergarten (TK)

EC section 48000(g) requires credentialed teachers who are first assigned to a TK classroom after July 1, 2015 to have one of the following by August 1, 2021:

24+ units in early childhood education, or childhood development, or both

 Professional experience in a classroom setting with preschool age children comparable to the 24 units of education described in bullet 1

Child Development Teacher Permit
